

This information is given to help parents and carers to support the work their children are doing in school. If you are planning a visit to the library or a bookshop there are ideas on what you could choose. If you are arranging a visit to an attraction, you might get some ideas. Alternatively if you are working together on the computer you can search for useful web sites.



SCIENCE: Farm Animals

We will look at the life cycles of farm animals, consider food chains and think about how farmers and vets care for these animals. We will think about farms we see around us and have a visit from the school farmer.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION: Gymnastics/ Dance

In Gymnastics, we will learn different wide, narrow and curled shapes. In Dance we will look at how to link different movements together with a partner.

Computing: Internet and Fact Files

We will be finding out more about Britain by using the internet. We will be introduced to the term 'algorithm' and begin to learn how we programme computers and roamers.

PERSONAL AND SOCIAL EDUCATION:

Getting on with our friends

We will learn what it means to be a good friend and how we can get along when we have fallen out. We will learn how to look after each other.

HISTORY: The Queen

We will be learning about Queen Elizabeth II. We will look at how Britain has changed since she began her reign in 1952. We will learn about the coronation and the Royal Family.

MUSIC : Music Express - Seasons

We will be developing our understanding of pitch movements. We will explore pitch through singing, tuned percussion and listening games.

GEOGRAPHY: We are Britain

We will learn more about Britain and what is special about each of the countries of Britain. We will map the different countries and look at their capital cities and surrounding seas.

ART: Sculpture and Painting

In Art we will be making our own sculptures using animals as a stimulus. We will be painting portraits of the Queen and looking at landscape paintings from around Britain.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: Why do Christians put a cross in an Easter garden?

We will be learning about the key events of Easter and understand the importance of these to Christians. We will be learning about the key symbols in an Easter garden.

DESIGN TECHNOLOGY: Pet Houses

We will be making a little home out of a box for a pet. We will think about the things we need to include to make sure they are carried safely.
