Science – Plants

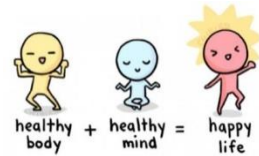
In Summer term, you will be learning more about plants. You will follow a plant's journey from a tiny seed to the growth of vegetables. You will consider what a plant



needs to grow and find out more about planting vegetables. You will grow your own vegetables in the school garden.

PSHE – Good to be Me

You will be learning to recognise all the things that are wonderful about you. You will also learn more about your feelings and how to deal with them in a positive way. In Summer 2, school will also hold our annual healthy week and register votes for the school council.



History – Local History

Our history topic this term will be about Rishworth and the local area. You will learn more about the mills and features of Rishworth in the past. You will learn more about mill life with a visit to Quarry Bank Mill.



Geography – Local Area

This term, you will learn more about the local area of Rishworth. You will map the area around school and look at some of the features in our local area like houses, shops and businesses.



Physical Education – Games and Athletics

You will learn different ways of using a ball. You will play games as an individual and with a partner. You will learn more about dribbling and receiving a ball. You will also learn more about athletics to prepare you for our annual Sports Day.



Religious Education- What makes some places sacred to believers?

You will learn more about special places of worship in Christianity, Islam and Judaism. You will learn more about how the church, synagogue and mosque are special to believers and find out more about worship that takes place there.



Design and Technology – Textiles

You will be learning more about Textiles and their importance in our local area. You will learn about weaving and how to weave. You will also have a go at fabric dyeing and printing.

Art – Drawing and sketching

You will be working on observational drawings and sketches. You will start by using different pencils to draw still life vegetables and progress to drawing objects around us in our local environment.



Music - Our School

You will explore different sound sources, materials and sound dynamics around the school. You will create a soundscape as part of a song performance.



Computing – Pictograms and Maze Explorers

In Computing, you will learn how to represent the class' favourite vegetables using a pictogram program on Purple Mash. You will also learn how to program a Bee-Bot to explore position and direction.
